## Supplies

Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™  
Royal Metallics® 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock

- 1 sheet Empress Emerald
- 1 sheet Castle Copper
- 1 sheet Sparkling Merlot
- 1 sheet Excalibur Steel

Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™  
Classics® 8-1/2" x 11"

- 1 sheet Exact Ice® White

Fiskars® Tools

- Apron lace border punch
- XL Round 'n Round squeeze punch
- L Oval squeeze punch
- M Heart punch

4" x 4" plastic zip top bag

Scissors

Black journaling pen

Candy corn

American Crafts™ Alpha Pals letter stickers

K and Company® small circle punch

Craft knife

Tape runner

Zip dry liquid adhesive

Small pop dots

## Instructions

1. Cut a piece of 4-3/4" x 5-1/2" Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Metallics® Castle Copper cardstock.
2. Lay the piece from Step #1 on your work space so the 4-3/4" side is at the bottom. Score the center of this piece horizontally, fold the cardstock in half. This piece is the candy bag topper and will cover the top of a 4" plastic zip lock bag.
3. Use the apron lace border punch to create a border piece from the Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Metallics® Excalibur Steel cardstock that is 4-3/4" in length. Trim this piece and place it under the front edge of the bag topper you created in Step #2. Attach to the topper with the tape runner.
4. Punch a circle out of Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Metallics® Empress Emerald using the XL circle squeeze punch. This will be the witch's head that decorates the bag topper.

5. Punch an oval from Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Metallics® Sparkling Merlot using the L Oval squeeze punch. Use a craft knife to cut a 1-1/2" slit lengthwise in the center of this oval. This will be the brim of the witch's hat.
6. With a scissors, cut a triangle 2-1/4" tall from Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Metallics® Sparkling Merlot. Slip the triangle base inside of the slit in the oval you created in Step #5 to create the witch's hat.
7. With a scissors, cut several 1/4" x 1-1/2" strips from the Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Metallics® Excalibur Steel cardstock. These will be the witch's hair.
8. Position the hat on top of the witch's head. Place the strips you cut in Step #7 so they are coming out the sides of the hat and overlapping on to the witch's face. Attach all pieces using zip dry adhesive.
9. Punch 2 eyes out of Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Classics® Exact Ice® White cardstock using the small circle punch. Use a black journaling pen to make small dots for pupils on the eyes. Attach the eyes to the witch's face with adhesive.
10. Using the M heart punch, create one heart from Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Metallics® Empress Emerald cardstock. With a scissors cut the heart in half.
11. Use a journaling pen to create short stitch marks around the half heart and attach it to the witch's face using a pop dot to make a nose as shown.
12. Attach the entire witch face to the bag topper with adhesive.
13. Use letter stickers to add a name or a saying to the bag topper. Fill plastic zip lock bags with candy corn; attach the topper to each bag using a stapler or an adhesive runner to secure in place.
