

Hot Cocoa Canister

The chill of winter is here which brings many fun outside activities. What better way to warm up than to use some wonderfully delicious colors and textures from the Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ to create this fun and useful canister. You can use it to store Hot Cocoa mix, tea, coffee, or whatever you desire!



Supplies

Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ 12"x12" Cardstocks

- 1 sheet Classics Blue
- 1 sheet Royal Fiber® Firecracker Red Bark texture
- 1 sheet Royal Complements® Umber Snowcrest texture

1 glass canister that measures 6 1/4" tall by 4" in diameter (I found mine at the local craft store)

Ranger Xmas Red Stickles (optional)

Making Memories Trademark Small white alphabet rub ons

Stampin' Up small snowflake stamp

Stazon Timber Brown Ink pad

Stazon Opaque Cotton White ink pad

Marvy Uchida 3" Scallop circle punch

Circle cutter

Fiskars® Threading Waters border punch and Scallop Sentiment border punch

Paper Trimmer

Therm O Web® 1/2" Super Tape

Therm O Web® Memory Tape Runner XL

24" of half inch red and white gingham ribbon

Small Safety or dressmakers pin

**Cricut machine

**Cricut Christmas Cheer cartridge

1/8" hole punch

***These items are optional. If you do not have a Cricut machine or the cartridges listed, you can use a sticker or pattern in place.*

Instructions

1. Cut a 5 1/4" x 12" piece of Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Fiber® Firecracker Red cardstock. Use the Scallop Sentiment border punch to create scallops on both long edges of this piece. Secure this to the jar using the Super tape.
2. Cut a 5 1/4" x 12" piece of Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Complements® Umber cardstock. Use the Threading waters border punch to go along the two long edges of this piece. Secure this on top of the previous piece making sure to match the scalloped edges.
3. Cut a 4 1/4" x 12" piece of Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Classics Blue cardstock.
4. Use the snowflake stamp and brown ink pad to create snowflakes on the blue piece from above. Make sure to run some off the edge so it looks like the pattern continues.

5. Attach the stamped Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Classics Blue over the top of the scalloped brown piece on your jar. Center it between the top and the bottom.
6. Cut two 1/4" x 12" pieces of Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Fiber® Firecracker Red. Wrap the first piece where the Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Complements® Umber cardstock meets your Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Classic Blue cardstock at the top and again at the bottom.
7. Take the 24" length of red gingham ribbon and cut it in half. Place one piece on top of the other and tie together in a bow. Once you have it secure then separate the loops and hanging strands to create a double bow look. Attach this to the top of the jar by the red band.
8. Use the large scallop punch to create a scalloped circle using the Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Complements® Umber cardstock.
9. Use the circle cutter to cut a 2 1/2" round piece of Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Fiber® Firecracker Red and a 2 1/4" round piece of Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Classics Blue. Ink the outside edge of the blue circle with brown ink. Layer these circles together and place on the scalloped circle from step #8.
10. Use the Cricut and Christmas Cheer cartridge to cut a 2" coffee mug and steam from Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Complements® Umber cardstock. Attach this to the center of the blue circle from above.
11. Punch a hole in the circular piece.
12. Thread the safety or dressmakers pin through the hole in the cocoa mug tag and pin this piece to the double bow.
13. Punch another scalloped circle from the Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Fiber® Firecracker Red.
14. Cut a 2 1/2" circle from your Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Complements® Umber piece using the circle cutter.
15. Use the snowflake stamp and opaque white ink pad to lightly stamp snowflakes all over the background of the brown circle from step #14.
16. Use the white rub on letters to label the jar "Hot Cocoa" and rub these on to the brown circle as shown.
17. Layer the Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Complements® Umber circle on top of the Wausau Paper® Creative Collection™ Royal Fiber® Firecracker Red circle. Attach this piece to the top of the jar.
18. This is an optional step that will give your project a little sparkle if you desire. Add a small dot of the red Stickers in each hole of the brown scalloped border. I also added a small dot of red Stickers to each scallop in my Cocoa mug tag as well. Allow this to dry.
